By signing, you acknowledge your understanding of our vision, mission, and methodologies, and your commitment to partner in your child's education.

1. Our Commitment to You

FUSION OUTSchool will:

- Provide a Christ-centered, literature-driven, synergistic learning environment.
- Maintain high moral and academic standards in all instruction and materials.
- Use Outstanding Works of Literature (OWLs) and high-quality curriculum that align with faith, family, and freedom values.
- Support each child's unique learning path through integrated, student-centered learning.
- Communicate regularly with parents about student progress, needs, and achievements.
- Ensure a safe, respectful, and welcoming environment for all students.

2. Parent/ Guardian Commitment:

I agree to:

- Support the ZION outSchool mission and values, including faith-based, literature-driven learning.
- Oversee at-home reading and assignments, ensuring my child is prepared for each class.
- Acquire required curriculum and OWLs in a timely manner (or borrow as available from school or library).
- Encourage and model respectful behavior toward staff, facilitators, and other students.
- Ensure consistent attendance and communicate promptly about absences.
- Partner in accountability for my child's learning by reviewing their work and progress.
- Honor financial commitments by paying tuition and fees on time, or arranging alternate tuition agreements as discussed.

3. Student Commitment

I agree to:

- Arrive on time and be prepared with materials, assignments, lunch, and a ready-to-learn attitude.
- Set a daily learning goal and work toward it with focus and perseverance.
- Treat fellow students, facilitators, and materials with respect.
- Follow classroom expectations for participation, conduct, and collaboration.
- Take ownership of my learning, including reading my OWLs and completing assigned projects.
- Ask questions and engage with curiosity.

4. School Uniform & Dress Expectations

- Zion outSchool students are required to wear the approved school uniform during school hours unless otherwise specified by administration.
- We chose scrubs deliberately. They are comfortable, durable, professional, and practical for students who think hard, move freely, and work with their hands. Students may wear any solid-color approved scrub set.
- Students are expected to arrive clean, neat, and prepared to participate fully in the learning environment. Hair, clothing, and grooming should support attentiveness and avoid unnecessary distraction or disruption. Hair should be kept sufficiently clear of the eyes during instruction and learning activities.
- Dress and grooming should reflect the thoughtful, respectful, and engaged learning culture we seek to cultivate at Zion outSchool.

5. Attendance & Make-Up Work

- Consistent attendance is essential for success at ZION outSchool.
- Parents must notify the facilitator in advance of absences when possible.
- Students are responsible for making up missed reading, assignments, and projects.

6. Tuition & Fees

- Annual Curriculum Fee: \$200 (Charged once per year · All students)
- Tuition: \$600/month (paid in advance; absences do not reduce tuition).
- Session Fee: \$135/session (due every 4 weeks → before each session starts).

7. Communication

- ZION outSchool will communicate primarily via GroupME, email, phone, and in-person meetings.
- Parents are expected to respond promptly to important communications regarding their child.

7. Agreement Termination

- ZION outSchool reserves the right to dismiss a student if their behavior, lack of participation, or family's repeated failure to meet commitments significantly disrupts the program.
- Parents may withdraw a student at any time with a 30-day written notice. Tuition is non-refundable for the current month.
